Educational Background

Portfolio Management Experience

Professional Business Experience

Secondary degree (high school diploma, associates degree or global equivalent)

10,500 hours (7 years) of unique non-overlapping professional portfolio management experience

A minimum of 8 years of professional business experience

OR

Four-year degree (bachelors degree or global equivalent)

6,000 hours (4 years) of unique non-overlapping professional portfolio management experience

A minimum of 8 years of professional business experience

All portfolio management experience must have been accrued within the last 15 consecutive years prior to the application submission. There is no time range for the professional business experience. General experience doesnt apply to portfolio management experience, but portfolio management

experience can count as professional business experience.

Where portfolio management experience cannot overlap, professional business experience can overlap with portfolio management experience.
